A presentation by Hagit Emma Werner, independent curator and architect based in Tel Aviv. Her primary practice and research focus on the "sonic event" and the perspective of listening. Among her curated projects are the exhibition series Composition for TimeSpace (2017) cocurated with Tal Lanir, Songs of the Next War (2016), and Cave Study (2015), all in the Tel Aviv Museum. Werner is also the founder and curator of SoundArtPassage (2013-2016) and is currently working on a new "Sound Space" to be open soon in Tel Aviv.
